

Mutual Non-Disclosure Agreement

Standard Form — for private consultations and engagements

This Mutual Non-Disclosure Agreement (the "**Agreement**") is made on *[Date]* between:

(1) **Mrs. Nidhi Sharma**, sole proprietor practising as **Lady of Destiny**, of Surajmal Vihar, New Delhi, India ("**the Practice**"); and

(2) *[Client name]*, of *[Client address]* ("**the Client**").

The Practice and the Client are each a "**Party**" and together the "**Parties**".

1. Purpose

In connection with an astrological consultation, engagement and related services (the "**Purpose**"), each Party may disclose to the other certain confidential and personal information. This Agreement sets out how such information is protected. The obligations are mutual and bind both Parties.

2. Confidential Information

"Confidential Information" means any non-public information disclosed by one Party (the "**Disclosing Party**") to the other (the "**Receiving Party**"), whether oral, written, electronic or in any other form, including: the Client's identity, personal and birth details, questions, circumstances and records; consultation contents, readings, recordings, written summaries and remedial recommendations; the Practice's methods, materials and pricing; and the existence and nature of the engagement itself.

3. Obligations of confidentiality

The Receiving Party shall: (a) keep the Confidential Information strictly confidential; (b) use it solely for the Purpose; (c) not disclose it to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent, save to professional advisers or associates bound by equivalent confidentiality; and (d) protect it using at least reasonable care and the security practices required under applicable law.

4. Exclusions

Confidential Information does not include information that: (a) is or becomes public other than through breach of this Agreement; (b) was lawfully known to the Receiving Party without obligation of confidence before disclosure; (c) is lawfully received from a third party without restriction; or (d) is required to be disclosed by law, court or regulator, in which case the Receiving Party shall, where lawful, give prompt notice to the Disclosing Party.

5. Personal data

Each Party shall handle personal data in accordance with applicable Indian law, including the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 and the Information Technology Act, 2000. The Practice's handling of personal data is further described in its Privacy Policy at drnidhisharma.com/legal/privacy.html.

6. Term & survival

This Agreement takes effect on the date above and the confidentiality obligations continue for five (5) years after the engagement ends, and indefinitely in respect of information that is sensitive personal information or that by its nature warrants continued protection.

7. Return or destruction

Upon written request, the Receiving Party shall return or securely destroy the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information, except for one copy that may be retained solely to comply with legal or record-keeping obligations, or as embedded in routine back-ups.

8. No licence; no obligation to proceed

Nothing in this Agreement grants any intellectual-property licence or right, other than the limited right to use the Confidential Information for the Purpose. This Agreement does not oblige either Party to enter into any further engagement.

9. Remedies

The Parties acknowledge that damages alone may be an inadequate remedy for breach, and that the Disclosing Party may seek injunctive or other equitable relief in addition to any other remedy available in law.

10. Governing law & jurisdiction

This Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India, and the Parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at New Delhi.

11. General

This Agreement is the entire agreement between the Parties on its subject matter and supersedes prior discussions. No variation is effective unless in writing and signed by both Parties. If any provision is held invalid, the remainder continues in effect. Failure to enforce any right is not a waiver of it.
